

**TOWN OF TOWNSHEND, VERMONT
ORDINANCE DESIGNATING COMMON ROAD
A ONE-WAY STREET**

Statement of Purpose: This ordinance has been adopted for the purpose of protecting public health, safety, order, and convenience.

Statutory Authority: This Ordinance has been promulgated under the authority granted to the Town's Legislative Body by the provisions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Section 1007 and 1008, and Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotated, Sections 1971 and 2291 (1)(4) and (5), and such other general enactments as may be material hereto.

Article I: Principal Provisions: The Ordinance establishes special traffic regulations on a public highway within the Town of Townshend, Vermont.

Article II: Designation of a One-Way Street: It shall be unlawful to operate a vehicle on a one-way street except in the indicated direction. Common Road is hereby designated as a one-way street and the direction of travel shall be as follows:

from the northernmost intersection of Common Road with Vermont Route 35, proceeding westerly and then southerly on Common Road a distance of approximately **468.0** feet to the intersection of Common Road with Vermont Route 30.

Publication and Posting:

This Ordinance shall be entered into the Select Board minutes, filed with the Town Clerk, and posted in at least five (5) conspicuous places within the Town of Townshend. A summary of this Ordinance shall be published in the *The Commons* not later than fourteen (14) days following the date specified below when this Ordinance is adopted.

Right to Petition:

Citizens of the Town of Townshend are further hereby notified that within forty-four (44) days from the date of adoption they may petition for a vote on the above Ordinance at an annual or special meeting as provided in 24 V.S.A. 1972(a).

Adoption/Effective Date:

This Ordinance is hereby adopted by the Select Board of the Town of Townshend on this the 24th day of October, 2017, and shall, unless a petition is filed as provided by law, become effective sixty (60) days from this date.
