1.	Call to Order:	Chairman Evans called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

6.	Old Business:	<u>Town Hall:</u> DeSiervo is waiting for comments and questions from other Commissioners before proceeding with further contact with Architect.
		Town Plan: Snelling introduced Mike McConnell a Senior Planner with Windham Regional Commission to speak about the process for applying for a state Municipal Planning Grant to fund the update of the town plan. He started by distributing a handout describing the Municipal Planning Grants that included a sample of the required Municipal Resolution and a sample of a WRC contract for assisting with the update of the town plan. The grants can be up to \$30,000 but they are competitive with only about 60% being awarded in the past. Applications are due between September 1 and November 1 <sup>st</sup> . The Commissioners in consultation with McConnell agreed that October 1 <sup>st</sup> would be a good target date to submit the application. McConnell inquired about key areas being considered for updates in the town plan. The group identified the following items for review: housing needs, Act 171 -Large Forest Blocks and Wildlife Corridors, Act 174 -Energy, flood resilience in light of recent events, community water systems for village, Townshend Dam & Lake usage and community facilities. McConnell asked about other stakeholders that should be involved or consulted in updating the town plan. Groups mentioned for possible outreach were Leland & Gray, Elementary School, Grace Cottage, Library and West River Community Project.
